France: Interactive map of pesticides used on the territory

The Toulouse-based organization SOLAGRO has produced an interactive map that allows everyone to find out the level of exposure to pesticides in the entire metropolitan territory. Called "ADONIS platform", the map is online and accessible since June 22, 2022.

Responding to the growing demand of citizens for information on the contamination of their environment, the platform provides information on the level of pesticide impregnation in French communes, based on the treatment frequency indexes (IFT) of phytosanitary products, collected in 2020. It also provides additional information such as the proportion of agricultural land, or the share of organic farming, in the municipalities. This information is supported by concrete examples of the main crops within a given municipality, and the most treated ones (e.g. vines).

With this interactive map, SOLAGRO's goal is above all *"to inform people so that the policy evolves in the right direction"*.

All this information comes from statistical data already available within the administration. For [Philippe Pointereau](#), delegate for development and agronomist at SOLAGRO, *"it is a release for everyone, both individuals, farmers, local communities, town halls, information that the State has, but have not made fully accessible ... We try to contribute, for the health of the population and for the protection of biodiversity, that these policies are more effective. We hope that with this map, everyone will move a little to see what to implement to speed up this exit from pesticides before there are no more insects."*

If you have made it this far, can you make one more small effort to allow us to continue this work of investigation and information to help the victims of pesticides?
